Installment Plan for Tuition: three options are offered for payment of tuition.

Option 1: Deposit of \$650 due January 31, 2017, with the remaining balance due July 1.

Option 2: Deposit of \$650 due January 31, 2017 with the remaining 60% due on July 1 and 40% due on December 1.

Option 3: Deposit of \$650 due January 31, 2017 with payments of 25% of the remaining balance due on April 1, July 1, October 1, and January 1.

Financial Aid:

St. George's Independent School offers need-based financial aid as determined by the school and Student Service for Financial Aid (SSS) of Princeton, NJ. St. George's Independent School does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, creed, national, or ethnic origin in the administration of its financial aid program. To apply for financial assistance, you must complete the Parents' Financial Statement (PFS) provided online by the School and Student Service (SSS) for Financial Aid. SSS processes the family's application and sends the school its assessment of the family's financial need. Please go to <http://sssbynais.org> to complete your application. The school's SSS code is 6458. Financial aid applications are considered complete when the SSS assessment is received along with a copy of the applicant's Form 1040 with accompanying schedules, as well as an executed enrollment contract and tuition deposit. It is recommended that those seeking aid file after December 1st but before March 1st. Should you have additional questions about financial assistance, please contact the Business Office.

St. George's offers Tuition Refund Insurance on an optional basis. As enrollment contracts are financially binding for the entire academic year, Tuition Refund Insurance is offered and strongly encouraged to insure against your tuition loss in the event that a student must withdraw from school during the course of the school year. All financial aid recipients are required to subscribe to the Tuition Refund Plan.
